Appellant Edward Lensby sought review of a June 3, 2002, decision of the Midwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to take 278 acres of land in the Town of Red Springs, Shawano County, Wisconsin, into trust for the Stockbridge-Munsee Community. By order of July 11, 2002, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) notified Appellant that he was required to serve a copy of his notice of appeal on the interested parties, and to certify to the Board that he had done so. The Board further informed Appellant that failure to take the steps required in its order would result in the dismissal of his appeal for failure to prosecute. Appellant's certificate of service was due on or before July 29, 2002.

The Board has not received a response from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
